# HIGH SCHOOL CAMP

## WHAT TO PACK

- Bible - we recommend sending your student with either the NIV or NLT version
- Pen
- Flashlight
- Sunscreen
- Sunglasses / Hat
- Refillable water bottle - labeled with students name
- Backpack (Drawstring bags are NOT recommended. Full-sized backpacks are best.)
- Clothes for each day + a few extra sets (some of these may get messy)
- Trash bag for wet/dirty clothes
- Light jacket for cool nights
- Raingear (rainjacket, poncho, or umbrella)
- Closed-toe shoes / tennis shoes
- Sleeping bag or sheets for a twin bed
- Pillow and a blanket
- Pajamas
- Water shoes for the lake and showers
- 2 Towels (1 for shower and 1 for lake)
- Toiletries (toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant, shampoo, body wash)
- Snacks (please do not bring peanuts or snacks containing nuts of any kind)
- Money (Optional)
  - For souvenirs - Glorieta Camps is cashless. Prepaid visa and debit cards are accepted. (Glorieta recommends no more than \$20)
  - For missions you can send your student with cash (find out more at [hillsideonline.com/camp](http://hillsideonline.com/camp))
- Wristwatch (optional)
- Attire for Theme Days

  -  Western
  -  Neon Night

## DRESS CODE

- No part of any undergarment should be visible
- All clothing should be undistracting
- No low cut tops
- No crop tops or bra tops
- No tight clothing (All leggings and biker shorts should remain covered)
- No short shorts
  - Girls - we recommend girls bring athletic shorts that have a minimum of 4-inch inseam.
  - Guys - we recommend guys pack athletic shorts and swim trunks that have a minimum of 7-inch inseam.
- Swimwear:
  - One piece swimsuit for girls.
  - Boys should wear a shirt to the lakefront.

*\*If a student's small group leader or a staff member discerns that a student is dressed in a way that does not meet the Camp Dress Code, we may speak directly with that student and encourage them to change clothes.*

## DO NOT PACK

- Cell phone
- iPads, Gaming Devices (such as a Nintendo Switch), E-readers, or any device that connects to WiFi
- Immodest/Inappropriate/Revealing Clothing
- Fireworks
- Drugs
- Fishing Poles
- Vapes/Juuls/or tobacco products
- Alcohol
- Weapons of any kind



Due to allergies, please do not bring peanuts or snacks containing nuts of any kind. (Examples: Nutella, Snickers, Reese's, peanut butter, almonds, cashews, walnuts, etc.)
