Weekly Parent Cues —

Preschool ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, cuddle them and say: "Good morning, [child's name]! Listen for a second. (Pause.) What do you hear? (Talk about sounds you hear.) I think it's amazing that God always hears you and God always hears me."



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child and pray: "Dear God, thank You for loving us no matter what and for always being with [name of child] and me. No one loves as big as You, God!"



Drive Time

While on the go, take turns saying: "God is with me when I go to [name of place]." End by saying: "God is always with me!"



Bath Time

Add bath crayons and toy cars to bath time. Ask your child to draw a road and then drive the cars on it. As they play, talk about the places where their car is going. Each time your child names a place, say: "God is with you when you go to the [name of place]."
