

Million Dollar Questions - Jesus asked them. How will you answer them? What is written in the Law? | Week 11

This resource can be used to guide your personal anchoring time throughout the week, a small group discussion, or even a one-on-one conversation.

READ

Begin by reading Luke 10:25-37.

- As you read, highlight the three different choices that were made in Jesus' story.
- Which of the three reactions shocks you the most?
- What questions do you have after reading these verses?

REFLECT

From Genesis to Revelation, the Bible is the inspired, holy Word of God. When Jesus asks, "What is written in the Law?" and "How do you read it?" He is asked how our understanding, discipleship, and obedience to it comes into play. God wants to encounter you through Scripture and know that Jesus died for your sins. Then, out of an overflow of that experience of love, God wants you to apply His Word in your life and share the hope of the Gospel with those around you.

- Read Luke 10:25-37. Briefly summarize that passage of scripture. What stands out to you about this story?
- Reread Luke 10:29. How often to do you try to justify your sin or disobedience to the law? What should you do instead?
- Read Psalm 1:1-2. What does mean to delight in the law of the Lord? What methods and approaches have you found to be helpful in reading and studying Scripture?
- Read 2 Timothy 3:16-17. How does reading the Bible equip you to love God and love people more?
- Read Galatians 6:2. Where is God challenging you this week to love people and help carry their burdens?

PRAY

Begin your time of prayer by reading 2 Corinthians 3:3-6. Read it slowly. Now, use this verse to guide your prayer. To get you started...

FOCUS on the love of Jesus and His sacrifice on the cross for you.

THANK the Holy Spirit for giving you new life.

CONFESS where you have tried to earn salvation rather than leaning upon God's love.

ASK God to give you the opportunity this week to share your faith.
